

Clancy Carbon Management Policy

Our commitment

Clancy is committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2050 at the latest whilst aiming for a more aggressive near-term target of 2030. We recognise that this is challenging and cannot be achieved alone and hence will promote a collaborative approach to attaining this goal.

We are committed to aligning with our customers, partners, competitors, and supply chain to ensure that collectively we can achieve this goal in a managed transition. This will promote collaborative working to accelerate the transition in a way that encourages innovation and best practice, while supporting manufacturers to bring their products to market.

Our Policy

Our approach is focussed on following three main areas over which we have operational control:

- Direct energy consumption in our offices and depots.
- Direct energy consumption in our on-road vehicle fleet and construction plant & equipment.
- Indirect energy consumed through the purchase of goods and materials for our non-project and project-based activities, business travel, water, consumables usage and waste management.

This will be delivered through:

- Delivering real carbon reductions before seeking other methods such as offsetting
- Utilisation of low carbon technology and materials where feasible based on a whole life value approach
- Use our Environmental Management System to manage and monitor reductions
- Engage and motivate our staff to deliver our carbon management programme
- Report transparently on our progress

Interim carbon targets will be identified and published as we develop our carbon reduction plan. Clancy will seek external accreditation for carbon management.

Our key responsibilities

The Clancy Group Board is accountable for the implementation of this policy. It's operational boards and managers are responsible for ongoing performance and control. This policy should be read in conjunction with our Environment Policy and within the context of our ISO14001 EMS.
