

Environment and Sustainability Policy Statement

Our Commitment

Clancy Group Holdings Limited and its subsidiaries (Clancy or we) is committed to safeguarding the environment, working sustainably on behalf of our clients.

We will demonstrate our commitment to the environment and sustainability by:

- Developing and implement a plan for achieving net zero carbon;
- Continuing to integrate sustainability principles and practices into all business decisions, examples of which can be found in the Annual Report and Accounts;
- Complying with all applicable environmental legislation and sustainability commitments;
- Preventing pollution and reduce consumption of resources through waste management strategies that promote waste minimisation by re-using, recovering, and recycling;
- Continuing to support community projects and organisations and help deliver wide-ranging social, economic and environmental benefits through the Clancy Charitable Foundation;
- Maintaining environmental performance by protecting biodiversity, ecosystems, the natural environment, heritage and archaeological features during the delivery of our activities;
- Empowering and motivate our employees and contractors to support this policy, our strategies and procedures through appropriate training to enhance environmental awareness;
- Continually enhance our knowledge in understanding and managing our footprint and continue to work closely with our supply chain to identify a credible and affordable path to decarbonizing our fleet and procuring lower impact materials for use on our projects;

- Working with suppliers and contractors who share our commitment to managing impact on the environment and ensure that environmental criteria (including climate change), are taken into account in the procurement of goods and services;
- Ensuring engine idling, fuel consumption and unnecessary emissions are minimised;
- Reviewing our processes to reduce harmful gas emissions from vehicles and equipment;
- Monitoring, reviewing and improving our Environmental Management System (EMS) and to maintain our EMS certification to ISO 14001:2015 through rigorous monitoring and review; and
- Monitoring, auditing and reviewing the effectiveness of this policy statement and improving where necessary.

Responsibilities

The Executive board is responsible for the commitments contained in this policy, and all Directors are responsible to the Chief Executive Officer for the implementation of this policy within their areas of control. All employees and contractors are aware of their duty to comply with the requirements set out in this policy and are informed of their responsibilities to ensure that they take all reasonable precautions, to ensure protection of any part of the environment that could be affected by the operation of our business. This policy will be continually monitored and updated annually and will be communicated to all employees and to those working on our behalf through our management systems or on our Intranet, One Clancy.
